Single-use foodware includes disposable cups, containers, & cutlery:

- Single-use items are commonly littered.
- Most **aren't recyclable**, especially when covered in food & grease.
- Products labelled "**compostable**" may not be accepted in green bins or break down in the environment.
- Manufacturing disposable foodware takes natural resources and energy, and it **causes pollution** for products that are used just one time.
